

RULES

Rules & Regulations

1. The show organisers reserve the right to cancel, add to or amend any of the Competitions as they see fit.
2. All classes listed in this schedule will be judged in accordance with the current British Showjumping rule book and the affiliated classes are confined to horses and ponies registered with British Showjumping and must be owned and ridden by members in accordance with Rule 79.
3. Some prizes may be withheld under rule 76.6.
4. If any person lodges an objection, such an objection should be made in writing, and a £100 deposit paid (Rule 198), to the Secretary within half an hour of the incident. The deposit will be refunded if the objection is sustained.
5. The Organisers & Land Owners will not be held responsible for any incident or injury to riders, owners, spectators or any person or property whatsoever, however caused. It is a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the promoters against any legal action arising from such incident.
6. No members shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorized agent or rider, to compete or be prepared to compete, in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk or injury-rule 82.21. Stallions are not allowed to compete on the "Ticket to Ride" scheme.
7. The decision of the Judge is final.
8. There will be a £4 surcharge for Paramedic cover.
9. **DOGS:** Due to Health & Safety Regulations dogs are not allowed out of the lorry or car park. Dogs are **not allowed** in the cafeteria, grandstands or competitions area.
10. Rule 164.1a will be applied (45 Second Count Down will be in operation).
11. All competitors will be required to produce their current membership card and current Horse Registration Card. If these cannot be produced a ticket may be purchased but prize money or qualification will not be given.
